Federal Great Lakes Restoration Initiative Improving the Health of Lake Michigan

The Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI) is a 5-year commitment from the Obama Administration to restore the health of the Great Lakes. Activities include cleaning up toxic contaminants and areas of concern; combating invasive species, protecting watersheds from polluted run-off, and restoring wetlands and other habitats.
